

MINUTES
August 10, 2026

The City Council of Badger met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. at Badger City Hall with Mayor Roger Curtis presiding. Council members present: Teresa Larson-White, Nathan Jones, Jeff Brundige, Michael Hendren, and Larry Hall. Mayor Curtis led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance. Motion to approve the agenda was made by Jones, second by Brundige, all ayes, motion carried. Motion to approve the consent agenda was made by Larson-White, second by Hendren, all ayes, motion carried. The consent agenda consisted of minutes from the July 13th meeting, clerk/treasurer report for July, and bills in the amount of \$29,424.15. Under communications and reports, Library director, Tammy Haack submitted and discussed her written report to Council regarding library happenings and events. Mark Wertz presented his written Public Works Department report which included numerous maintenance tasks, work with equipment, utility locates, etc. He also reported on a sampling issue. Glenda Rasmussen, City Clerk, presented her written report to Council. Clerk will be on vacation for most of the final two weeks of August. Council had nothing to report. Mayor Curtis discussed some progress on tree removal after initial letters were sent out. Under regular agenda items, council discussed sending an RFP for a new city attorney so that a decision can be made at the September meeting. Next, Council discussed holding a local paint collection event. It was agreed that the city would not serve as a collection point. City staff will post flyers provided by the landfill regarding dates where the public can drop off paint to them free of charge. There being no other business, motion to adjourn was made by Brundige, second by Hendren, all ayes, motion carried. Adjournment at 7:03 p.m.
