

MINUTES
December 08, 2025

The City Council of Badger met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. at Badger City Hall with Mayor Chris Wendell presiding. Council members present: Roger Curtis, Teresa Larson-White, Pam Smith, Jeff Brundige and Nathan Jones. Also present: Larry Hall, Michael and Michelle Hendren, Chris and Natalie Kinder, and Tammy and Mark Haack. Motion to approve the agenda was made by Smith, second by Curtis, all ayes, motion carried. Motion to approve the consent agenda was made by Jones, second by Larson-White, all ayes, motion carried. The consent agenda consisted of minutes from the November 10th meeting, Clerk/Treasurer report for November, and bills in the amount of \$18,435.15. There was no unscheduled business. Under communications and reports, Library director, Tammy Haack submitted her written report to Council regarding library happenings. Mark Wertz presented his written Public Works Department report which included numerous maintenance tasks, work with equipment, utility locates, etc. Glenda Rasmussen, City Clerk, presented her written report to Council. Council and Mayor had nothing to report. Mayor Wendell opened the public hearing on the FY26 Budget Amendment #1 at 6:32 p.m. There were no comments received and the public hearing was closed at 6:33 p.m. Under regular agenda items, a motion to approve Emilee Johnson as a new library board member, replacing Tammy Haack on the board, was introduced by Curtis, second by Brundige. All ayes, motion carried. Council discussed the timeline put together by the clerk for the FY27 budget proceedings. The budget will begin being discussed at the January 12th meeting, with a budget workshop to be held on January 26th. A motion to approve Resolution 12-02-25 Adopting FY26 Budget Amendment #1 was made by Curtis, second by Smith, all ayes, motion carried. There being no other business, motion to adjourn was made by Curtis, second by Jones, all ayes, motion carried. Adjournment at 6:38 p.m.
