

MINUTES
January 12, 2026

The City Council of Badger met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. at Badger City Hall with Mayor Roger Curtis presiding. Council members present: Teresa Larson-White, Jeff Brundige, Nathan Jones, Michael Hendren and Larry Hall. Also present: Tammy Haack. Motion to approve the agenda was made by Hall, second by Hendren, all ayes, motion carried. Motion to approve the consent agenda was made by Brundige, second by Larson-White, all ayes, motion carried. The consent agenda consisted of minutes from the December 8th meeting, Clerk/Treasurer report for December, and bills in the amount of \$13,397.37. There was no unscheduled business. Under communications and reports, Library director, Tammy Haack submitted and discussed her written report to Council regarding library happenings. Mark Wertz presented his written Public Works Department report which included numerous maintenance tasks, work with equipment, utility locates, etc., but was absent. Glenda Rasmussen, City Clerk, presented her written report to Council. Council and Mayor had nothing to report. Mayor Curtis made the following appointments to various boards: Mayor Pro-Tem is Michael Hendren. 911/EMA boards is Teresa Larson-White. Mayor will remain as representative on the Landfill board and will also serve on the Conference Board in Webster County. Larry Hall and Michael Hendren will serve with the mayor on the Fire Board. Under regular agenda items, council, clerk and mayor discussed the FY27 budget. A budget workshop will be held January 26th. Final item was a motion to approve Resolution 01-01-26 Naming Depositories and Authorized Signators for the Investment of Public Funds. Motion introduced by Hall, second by Hendren, all ayes, motion carried. There being no other business, motion to adjourn was made by Curtis, second by Jones, all ayes, motion carried.
