

**MINUTES**  
**November 10, 2025**

The City Council of Badger met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. at Badger City Hall with Mayor Chris Wendell presiding. Council members present: Roger Curtis, Teresa Larson-White, Pam Smith and Nathan Jones. Absent: Jeff Brundige. Also present: Larry Hall and Cyndi Dencklau. Motion to approve the agenda was made by Smith, second by Curtis, all ayes, motion carried. Motion to approve the consent agenda was made by Smith, second by Jones, all ayes, motion carried. The consent agenda consisted of minutes from the October 13th regular meeting and November 3<sup>rd</sup> special meeting, Clerk/Treasurer report for October, and bills in the amount of \$37,394.50, the FY25 Street Finance Report and the FY25 Annual Financial Report. There was no unscheduled business. Under communications and reports, Library director, Tammy Haack submitted her written report to Council regarding library happenings. She also reported that the library had received a Deardorf grant to purchase some equipment and other items for the library. Mark Wertz presented his written Public Works Department report which included numerous maintenance tasks, work with equipment, utility locates, etc. Glenda Rasmussen, City Clerk, presented her written report to Council. Council had nothing to report but Smith asked who would be in charge of replacing or repairing the sidewalk in front of the fire department. Council and clerk agreed that it would be the property owner's responsibility. Mayor had nothing to report. Under regular agenda items, Paul Butterfield had requested a variance on a building timeline for a lot in Badger Ridge. Normally, construction on a lot would need to be completed within two years of purchase. Butterfield requested to be able to begin, not complete, construction within two years. Motion to approve request was made by Larson-White, second by Curtis, all ayes, motion carried. Council then discussed new mandatory training on open meetings and open records. Clerk will take care of the registrations for those that will attend training. Next, a motion to set the public hearing date for a FY26 budget amendment to be at the December 8<sup>th</sup> council meeting was made by Jones, second by Curtis, all ayes, motion carried. The final item was approval of the donation agreement with the Badger Lions for FY26. Motion made by Jones, second by Smith. Ayes: Jones, Smith, Larson-White. Nays: none. Curtis abstained. There being no other business, motion to adjourn was made by Curtis, second by Smith, all ayes, motion carried. Adjournment at 6:49 p.m.
