ORDINANCE NO. 306

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BADGER, IOWA. 2014
BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO STOP SIGNS IN BADGER RIDGE, PHASE I.

Be it Enacted by the City Council of the City of Badger, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Chapter 65, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Badger, Iowa, 2014, by adding the following provisions, which is hereby adopted as follows:

- 65.01 STOP REQUIRED. Every driver of a vehicle shall stop in accordance with the following.
 - 15. 5th Street SE. Vehicles traveling South on 5th Street SE shall stop at 3rd Avenue SE.
 - 16. 6th Street SE. Vehicles traveling South on 6th Street SE shall stop at 3rd Avenue SE.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from after its final passage, approval and posting as provided by law.
